8 THIS MATTER having come before the Court upon the Motion of the Defendant for an Order  
9 Setting Aside Conviction and Sealing Records of Arrest, pursuant to ORS 161.685 (5); the State  
10 of Oregon appearing by and through the District Attorney for Linn County and the Court having  
11 reviewed the records and being fully advised, finds as follows:

- 12 1. A copy of the Motion to Set Aside and Affidavit in Support were served upon the District  
13 Attorney for Linn County.  
14 2. The Court having thoroughly reviewed Defendant’s claims of MANIFEST HARDSHIP due to  
15 fines and costs imposed upon the Defendant by the court finds that the Defendant has  
16 demonstrated to the court good cause to set aside court fines, costs and any unpaid fines and  
17 costs.

18 NOW THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Defendant herein is deemed by the  
19 Court to be financially unable to presently pay fines, costs and unpaid fines and costs imposed by  
20 the court and the Defendant’s motion to Set Aside Obligations to Pay Court Fines and Costs Due  
21 To a Manifest Hardship is hereby granted and the same is hereby set aside.

22 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Defendant will provide to the court upon request  
23 disclosure of financial status to determine Defendant’s ability to pay in the future.

24 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk of the Court shall enter a judgment against the  
25 Defendant for the amount of all costs, fines and any unpaid costs and fines and said judgment  
will remain in full effect until such time Defendant becomes able to satisfy said judgment and  
pays said judgment in full.
